Across England, this vision comes to life through the creation of native woodlands in areas where tree cover has been lost or simplified. These new forests are designed to fit the local soils and climate, bringing back the layered structure and diversity that once defined the countryside.



Restoring Ecosystems and Wildlife Corridors

New woodland reduces erosion, protects waterways, and improves resilience to extreme weather. It also provides food and shelter for a wide range of species, while connecting existing small woodlands, hedgerows, and river corridors into richer habitat networks.



Strengthening Communities Through Woodland Work

This project offers seasonal and ongoing work in nurseries, planting, and woodland care, alongside opportunities for volunteering and community plant days. Expanded green spaces will also provide the community with more opportunities to connect with nature, supporting health, wellbeing, and fostering pride in the area.
